

Venture inside the powerful exteriors to see superb collections and hear unique stories of the people who lived and worked here. Explore the picturesque parklands surrounding the magnificent castle and watch the red and fallow deer from afar.


Soak up stunning panoramic views of the castle across the High Vinery garden whilst enjoying seasonal and locally sourced flavours from our carefully crafted menus.


